- Tournament form:** Individual – stroke play Stableford; over 36 holes
NOT handicap qualifying;
- Starting times:** Round 1: 18 holes: Saturday, 3.10.2009 at 10.00 a.m.
Round 2: 18 holes: Sunday, 4.10.2009 from 9.30 a.m. on
(approximate starting times)
- Conditions of competition:** **Tees:** beginners course, yellow/ red
The tournament is played in accordance with the rules of the
"German Golf Federation (DGV) Conditions of Competition 2009"
and the local rules etc.
- Committee:** WINSTONgolf Klub e.V.
The members of the committee will be made known before the start
of the competition.
- Eligibility of play:** Eligible to play are all amateurs who are members of a registered
golfclub (DGV or EGA).
- Handicap limit:** 37 – 54

If the handicap improves to –36.0 and better, the player will move
up to the tournament on the WINSTONcourse. But that will only be
possible, if
- there are free starting positions at the tournament at the
WINSTONcourse and
- the handicap changes until 31.07.2009. If the handicap changes
later, it cannot be considered, and the participant enters the
tournament with his current handicap.

Play-off:

With a tie score after 36 holes, the last 18 holes will decide a winner. Then it is scored on the basis of nine of the holes played, which were counted after degree of difficulty according to the default distribution (1, 18, 3, 16, 5, 14, 7, 12, 9).

If the scores are still equal with degree of difficulty 1, 18, 3, 16, 5, 14 and afterwards 1, 18, 3 and, finally, the most difficult hole will count. If the scores are still equal then the tie will be decided on in accordance with the DGV Conditions of Competition.

Termination of tournament:

The tournament ends with victory ceremony or with publication of the entire tournament list.

Subject to change:

The competition committee reserves the right to alter starting times and amend the regulations if necessary. Decisions of the competition committee will be final (subject to alterations without notice).

The golf management and the club are not responsible for disadvantages which a participant suffers as a result of unawareness of afore stated information. Every participant recognises with his registration the conditions which are binding for every tournament. Once you have registered for the tournament (submitted your application), you are required to pay the entry fee. If the fee is not paid, you won't be able to play in any other tournaments until the fee is paid in full.
